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Martin Choo is an HIV treatment activist who champions the right to health and equitable access to mental and sexual healthcare. He is the Managing Director of Asia Pacific Council of AIDS Service Organizations, a regional charity licensed by the Malaysian Ministry of Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs. Martin is a life member of the Kuala Lumpur AIDS Support Services Society (KLASS), and a community researcher affiliated with the Asia Pacific Network of People Living with HIV (APN+). He is a member of the World Health Organization (WHO) HIV drug resistance research network global steering group (2018-2021) and multiple guidelines development groups; specifically, on the use of antiretroviral drugs for treating and preventing HIV infection (2015, 2018, 2019), HIV testing services (2015), HIV self-testing and partner contact tracing (2016), and the public health response to HIV drug resistance (2017). He is living with HIV since 2004.
